SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

The Korea University of Technology and Education (KoreaTech) designed the Global Engineering and Technology (GET) scholarship program in response to the global demands of business and industry. The scholarship covers all tuition costs for the duration of the degree (4 years). The goal is to produce outstanding engineers with international skills and experience who, after graduation, can return to their home country to promote technological education. In addition to the scholarship, the university gives students the opportunity to work part-time on-campus as cultural activity assistants to cover their food and dormitory costs.

AVAILABLE MAJORS

- **Mechanical Engineering**
Curriculum includes courses related to mechanics and robotics
- **ICT (Information & Communication Technology)**
Curriculum includes related courses on electricity, electronics, computer and communications technology

COMPETITION PROCESS

- 1st round application through Vytautas Magnus University's Center for Asian Studies.
- KoreaTech will judge 1st round submissions and select 10 finalists. The finalists will all receive a special gift from KoreaTech.
- The finalists will then be interviewed and asked to present their submissions in English (2nd round).
- A maximum of 3 prospective students will be chosen from the 2nd round to be eligible for the GET full scholarship from KoreaTech, which is a free 4-year undergraduate engineering education.
- Candidates who pass the second round must submit an official English score before 31 July 2012 in order to receive the GET scholarship. The latest possible dates that students can take such a test in Lithuania are: TOEFL – June 30, IELTS – July 12.

COMPETITION SCHEDULE

- **April.01– April 30, 2012**
1st round applications accepted

1st round finalists announced on Vytautas Magnus University's Asian Studies Department website

2nd round English presentations and interviews
- **May 24, 2012**
2nd round finalists (prospective scholarship candidates) announced on Vytautas Magnus University's Asian Studies Department website

Start of semester at KoreaTech

CONDITIONS & ELIGIBILITY

- The applicant and both of his or her parents must be non-Korean nationals.
- The applicant must have good spoken and written English.
- The applicant must have finished or be scheduled to finish high school between September 1, 2010 and September 1, 2012.

GET SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

- Full scholarship for 4 consecutive academic years.
- In order to maintain the scholarship, a minimum GPA of 2.0 (C0) is required for the first year. All subsequent years require a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- In order to receive their meal allowance and dormitory costs, students are required to work for at least 7 hours per week as cross-cultural activity assistants. This part-time employment program also enables students to earn money during the summer and winter vacation periods, which their scholarship does not cover.
